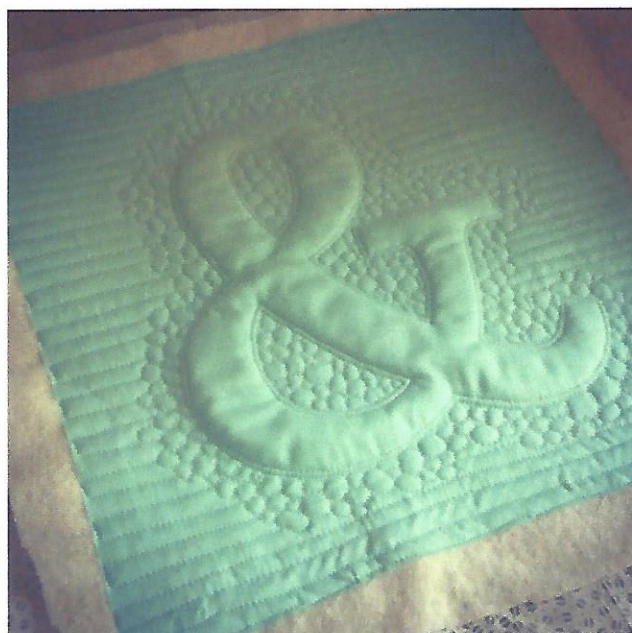


Text Trapunto Technique

This is a technique pattern. This resource is designed to teach you basic trapunto styling for you to add interest and personalization to your projects. You can add text to any quilt design. It works especially well in modern/contemporary quilts that are just begging you to fill in that “negative” space.

Let's start with a test or sample block measuring 15" x 15", finished.

(Images will be of various letters.)

Supplies:

- 2 Fat Quarters
- 1 square of scrap batting 18" square
- Water Soluble Thread
- 2 additional pieces of batting scraps, larger than your monogram design
- Machine Quilting “hopper” foot attachment
- Quilting thread
- Sharp, small scissors
- Non-permanent marking pen
